

### Should I attend academic activities or come to campus if I have influenza-like symptoms?

No. Students with flu-like symptoms should stay home until the symptoms are gone. Flu-like symptoms include sudden onset of the following:

- cough and fever, sometimes with chills and sweating spells; plus
- one or more of the following: fatigue, muscle and/or joint aches, sore throat, headache, decreased appetite, runny nose.

Students who are absent due to the H1N1 flu or who have flu-like symptoms must contact their Academic Advisor who will direct you on the process for academic accommodation and required documentation.

### What do I do if I miss a Final Exam due to influenza-like symptoms?

- stay home and advise your academic advisor by phone or email;
- follow the “request for deferred examination” process outlined in the University of Ontario Institute of Technology 2009 – 2010 undergraduate calendar (see section 5.24.1.4); and
- consult your Academic Advisor if an extension for documentation is required.
