



# Scholarship Application Form

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This scholarship is one of the University of Ontario Institute of Technology's most prestigious entrance awards. The recipients of this award will be academically outstanding and have made notable contributions in extracurricular or community activities. The Awards Committee will make selections based on these qualifications.

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## Value

Global Leadership Award: \$45,920 (\$11,480 per year over four years) One awarded annually.

## Criteria

- Nominated by high school. Only one candidate per school will be considered for this award.
- *An excellent academic record ("A" average or equivalent)*
- Personal leadership activities: e.g. excellence in extracurricular activities beyond academic requirements and/or significant contributions to community or family
- Undergraduates studying towards their first university degree
- High school applicants currently studying outside of Canada only
- Non-Canadian residents only

To qualify for renewal of these awards, students must maintain an average of *80% or 3.7 GPA* on a full-time course load ( as per UOIT's grading scale).

## Application Process

1. Complete all of the sections of this application. All information must be typed on additional paper. Handwritten applications will be discarded.
2. Ensure that the references are in sealed envelopes that are stamped or signed across the seal by the referee. References must accompany the application. Please do not supply more than two letters of reference.
3. Applications must be received no later than **February 27, 2009**. Late applications and incomplete applications will not be reviewed, nor will applicants be notified.
4. Successful applicants will be notified in March.

Important: To be considered for this award, students must have an official application to the university on file. Please apply through the Ontario Universities' Application Centre - [www.ouac.on.ca](http://www.ouac.on.ca) - by February 1.
